## **INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT**

We have audited the accompanying financial statements 2014 of Foundation Human Security Collective at 's-Gravenhage, which comprise the balance sheet as at December 31, 2014, the profit and loss account for the year then ended and the notes comprising a summary of the accounting policies and other explanatory information

### **Management's responsibility**

An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.
